



Join 4-H



If you are between the ages of 5 and 18, you can get involved in 4-H by calling the Putnam County Extension office and asking to talk with the 4-H agent or program assistant. You can also visit Putnam County's website: <http://putnam.ifas.ufl.edu/4H/index.shtml>.
